Long Island Expressway to Exit 73. Take that exit to the end. County Route 58. Go several lights (approx.3-5 lights) and make a right onto Harrison Avenue. (Taco Bell and Laundry Palace are on the corners). Riverhead Middle School is on your left. Make a left at the light into the school parking light. Take the driveway all the way around to the back of the building. Enter via the marked doors.
