NOTE THE FOLLOWING APPLIES TO ALL EVENTS:

- All individual athletes and all members of the team or line MUST be enrolled full time at the school they attend.
- Gymnastics allowed in programs.
- Videotaping is permitted

College Band Directors, Twirling Coaches/Directors and Lines:

This is your opportunity to visit with potential high school students about your school's program and present what your university has to offer. Take advantage of the chance to come and meet these kids and to witness their performances in competition on Saturday.

AWARDS

Individual Events: 1st through 6th place medallions, certificates to all individual participants.

Group Events: 1st through 3rd place plaques, certificates to individual members of the group.

Additional awards will be presented if entries warrant.

Placements in each of the events accumulate for each school to determine the winner. High Schools & Universities/Colleges may enter an unlimited number of athletes, however the points will be awarded for only the top three placements in each category per school. Points will be awarded in the reverse of how many entrants there were total. The highest point total for the Universities/Colleges wins. (If there are 20 competitors entered in the solo event the 1st place winner will earn 20 points for their school).

AWARDS PRESENTATION & BANQUET RECEPTION
