<p><i>Focusing on basic technique, theory and performance skills, participants are trained to evaluate the C and B levels of compulsories and movement technique and to judge basic and military strut. Applicants are also introduced to the Competitive Achievement System and educated in the USTA philosophies and standards by which all judges are held accountable.</i></p> <p>Applicants are offered two options for completing this course: Home-study or an 8-hour workshop. Both options include a written exam (open book) and video testing.</p> <p>To complete this course at home, applicants must purchase the home-study materials. These include the training/testing video, the test, and the Judges' Level I Manual. Applicants attending a Part I workshop only need to purchase the manual.</p> <p>Judges who pass Level 1, Part 1 are certified to evaluate C and B Compulsories and Movement Technique, and judge Basic and Military at local contests.</p>	<p><i>Participants receive training in developing their skills in recognizing all aspects of technique for all levels of compulsories and movement technique (except Elite) and all foundation events. They also receive instruction in utilizing the scoring scale. Basic design concepts and performance skills are introduced.</i></p> <p>Applicants may be certified as Level I, Part 2 judges by attending the Level I, Part 2 workshop, and passing the written exam (open book) and video test. This workshop is a one-day, eleven-hour workshop.</p> <p>Applicants must purchase the current Judges' Level I Manual.</p> <p>Judges who pass Level 1, Part 2 are certified to evaluate C through AAA Compulsories and Movement Technique, and judge Basic, Military, Presentation, Rhythm Twirl and Standard Solo at local, state and regional contests.</p>

Requirements: Level I, Part 2 – must be a professional member of USTA and completed Level I part 1 (You can still take the test if Part I is not completed – you will not receive your results until then)

Materials needed: Judges' Level I Manual (mandatory). Cost: \$45. Order in advance from USTA, http://www.ustawirling.com/store/index.asp?category_id=616

Advance Preparation: Participants must be familiar with the material in the handbook.

What to bring: Judges' Level 1 Manual, notebook, post-it notes, pens, highlighter, baton.

Additional Information:

Need minimum of 6 people for workshop. Any professional members, 16 years or older, may attend judges workshops for information purposes, however attendees must be 18 years or older to test for certification.
