GENERAL INFORMATION

ORDER OF EVENTS: Group events/Freestyle, Compulsories/Movement Technique, Basic, Military, Presentation, Strut, Solo and pairs, 2-baton & 3-baton, flag and rifle, Dance Twirl. Trick meet will be held during lunch break.
MEMBERSHIP: ALL ATHLETES must be a member of USTA or pay the \$8.00 to become a member for a day. Teams and corps may hold a group or organization membership or each individual member of the team or corps my have an individual membership. Membership number must be listed on entry, or member for a day fee MUST accompany entry.
ADMISSION FEE: There will be no admission fee for this contest. A \$5.00 per family surcharge has been added to each individual entry to help defray the cost of gym rental and will include 1 program per family, additional programs \$1.00.

REFUNDS:

NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR ANY REASONS.

AGE:

All athletes must compete at the age they will be on 12/31/07.

ERRORS:

If a contestant makes a mistake on the entry, mistakes will not be corrected and contestant will not be allowed to perform.

TIME:

Doors open at 9:00 a.m.; contest begins at 10:00 (WA State Championships begin at 9:00 a.m.)

GROUP EVENT INFORMATION: (Washington State Championships)

- 1st, 2nd and 3rd place awards in each group.
- Age divisions:
 - Tiny Tot – All members 7 years of age or less
 - Primary – Average age of 9.9 or less
 - Juvenile – Average age of 10.0-12.9; or oldest member 10-12 years
 - Junior – Average age of 13.0-15.9; or oldest member 13-15 years
 - Senior – Average age of 16.0 or more; or one or more members 16 years or older
- A small show corps has 8-14 twirling members; a large show corps has 15 or more twirling members. Parade corps has 8 or more.
- A small team has 4-8 members; a large team has 9 or more members; a trio has 3 members.
- Each member of a team or corps, including musicians and color guard, must hold some type of USTA membership, or the team or corps must have a group membership. Director will send in corps and team entries and will list names and ages of members of each team and corps. Entry must include photocopy of membership(s).
- Judging tapes for corps and teams will be provided by the contest director.
- Music may be on cassette tape or CD.

3. The divisional winners will twirl or strut off in completion for sweepstakes titles in solo, strut, boys, two baton, three baton, and dance twirl. High score for the day will determine pairs sweepstakes champion.
4. Awards: 1st Plaque, 2-3 Medallions, 4-9 USTA medals in each divisional event.
