TEAM TRANSFORMATION

Twirl Team or Dance Twirl Team: WHAT'S IN A NAME?

Whether you have been involved with USTA for 20 years or 2 months, you might have wondered why there are two different categories for team: Twirl Team and Dance Twirl Team. Is one team event focused on dance moves



more than twirling? Not exactly. The expectations for both Twirl Team and Dance Twirl Team from a judging perspective are that equal attention is paid to the development of both baton and body. Historically, Dance Twirl Teams have taken a wide range of artistic risk in terms of theme, character and costume. The main focus of Dance Twirl Team is to display a musically driven program that showcases the blending of baton and body highlighting dance variety and technique.



Then the question remains: what is a Twirl Team? This very question led to the development of the new Twirl Team concept and content guidelines. Twirl Teams should also be musically driven and they should showcase all aerial modes, synchronic twirling, a roll section and multiple baton. These event clarifications will take effect in September 2019 for the 2019-2020 season. Twirl Teams will no longer be classified by



Beginning, Intermediate or Advanced. Instead, teams will enter competitively



based on the skill level of the athletes. We have created five skill levels for Twirl Team to guide coaches. These skill level classifications will result in



a content restriction penalty for those teams who include material outside the scope of their level. Also, the time limit for Twirl Team will expand to allow for younger or less proficient athletes to benefit from shorter routine length.

Be on the lookout for more communication regarding the upcoming changes. Here's what you need to know now:

No changes will be made to the Dance Twirl Team event.

Changes to Twirl Team will begin in September 2019.

There will be judges' training as well as opportunities at Nationals and iTwirl19 this fall for coaches to ask questions about the new Twirl Team concept and guidelines.



USTA CREATIVE CHALLENGE GRANT: STAT of Illinois

STAT of Illinois brings baton twirling to underserved children

Carol Lites has been sharing her passion for baton twirling with children in the south Chicago area for more than 40 years. She loves how the sport helps them discover abilities they didn't know they had, develop poise and self-confidence and live a healthier lifestyle.

"Baton twirling keeps a child active and it battles childhood obesity," Lites said.

A twirler from the age of six on, Lites developed a lifelong love of the sport, as did her daughters, Kanisha Ku and Carmen Young. They grew up twirling, and now coach with their mother at Sheer Talent and Technique, or STAT, of Illinois. Lites founded STAT nine years ago to offer instruction in baton, flag and dance to children, ages five and older, who live in the south Chicago area. It's a part of town where many families struggle to meet daily expenses, much less pay for extracurricular activities for their children.

Lites would like to offer more young



people the opportunity to participate in baton twirling, which is why she recently applied for a Creative Challenge Grant from USTA.

"We applied for the grant because of who we serve," explained Lites. "We serve the underserved. A lot of our students are from single-parent families. Some have been affected by violence in the Chicago area."

USTA's Board of Directors established the Creative Challenge Grant

program last fall. It's designed to fund projects that promote increased participation in the sport of baton twirling. Applicants had to explain how their project would benefit their organization and USTA, what the short-term changes and long-term impacts might be and what criteria would be used to evaluate the project's success.

Lites submitted a request and was approved for a grant that will provide batons and costumes for a team of five young twirlers. It will also cover their fee to enter Basic and team at the Illinois State Championships and Open Contest on April 5.

Lites said her students were thrilled with their new batons and costumes and are working hard to prepare for competition. She said the grant is giving them the opportunity to participate in a positive, healthy activity where they are also learning important life skills such as perseverance and teamwork.

"I'm excited that USTA has done this and given these kids the opportunity to learn this awesome sport," Lites said. "I'm very grateful for it."





Baton twirling helps GiGi's Playhouse twirlers achieve "best of all"

GiGi's Playhouse was created to change the way the world views a Down syndrome diagnosis and send a global message of acceptance for ALL. In the summer of 2002, founder Nancy Gianni gave birth to her daughter, GiGi. What began as a mother's vision to change perception and maximize her daughter's successes has evolved into a global movement of acceptance. The very first playhouse was created to be an inspirational and dedicated place for families to celebrate their child and benefit from free, purposeful programs that unleash joy, confidence and continuous improvement. More than 40 playhouses empower children and adults to achieve their "best of all" and pursue their dreams.

children, although it may take children with Down syndrome longer than other children to reach developmental milestones. Cognitive impairment, problems with thinking and learning, is common in people with Down syndrome as well, and usually ranges from mild to moderate. Other common cognitive and behavioral problems include short attention span, poor judgment, impulsive behavior and slow learning.

When I first started coaching the girls at GiGi's Playhouse Fort Wayne,

My mother, Lorri Meyer, was on the start-up committee to bring a GiGi's Playhouse to Fort Wayne and serves on the Board of Directors. She suggested I start a twirling program to help with both the physical and mental aspects of Down syndrome because the earlier those aspects are treated, the better chance a child has to reach their full ability and live a meaningful life. Because of poor muscle tone, a child with Down syndrome may be slow to learn to turn over, sit, stand and walk. Despite these delays, children with Down syndrome can learn to participate in physical exercise activities like other

I was a little nervous. I wasn't sure I would be able to influence my students in the manner necessary. However, as time progressed, I watched the girls' memory of the movements and tricks improve and my confidence in my ability to reach them increased. I did need to adjust my teaching style to each girls' individual traits as some children with Down syndrome do not like to be touched, some have attention problems, and others may have a stubborn or oppositional behavioral issue. But, each week we set different goals that reflect the GiGi's motto of achieving your



“best of all” and each little success is celebrated.


One thing I was not expecting from coaching those with Down syndrome was how much a part of my life it has become and how fun we have. I love how I help these girls gain confidence and help them become the best person they can be. Every time I see improvement I become excited and that helps the girls get excited and want to do a great job. We have been working on new tricks this fall and winter and are ready to put our routine together for this year's Gala. I have started introducing exchange work, as well as 2-baton material and I can't wait to see them shining on the stage in front of 400 people this spring.



ABOUT MALLORY KUTER

I started twirling at age seven when my mother (who twirled a little when she was young) found a class listed in our local recreation brochure. I fell in love with twirling and was doing contests and parades within the first year. Two years later we moved to Fort Wayne and my mom found a USTA coach who put me on a team with girls my age. I traveled to Kansas City for nationals the following summer and I ended up taking 7th in Advanced Solo, 2nd in Intermediate Solo, 4th in Dance Twirl, and when my team won 1st place in both the Twirl and Dance team events I was hooked! I began taking lessons from Kyle Keiser when I was 11. She put me on a team with some of the older twirlers I really admired. It was such an honor being a student of Kyle's and she taught me to be a confident young woman. Under Kyle's teachings I won my first state title at the age of 14, my first regional title at the

age of 16 and placed second at nationals in 2002. My biggest accomplishment as a twirler was making the World Team in 1999 and taking 5th place in the Pairs event.


